Comments	<input type="text" value="This application seems rather a lot of dwellings in very small space. This, alongside other developments, are changing the ideal of a Garden City. High rise dwellings are not in keeping with our heritage here and such an influx of people cannot be supported but the current infrastructure. Roads are already gridlocked at rush hour, we no longer have a local A&E and our minor injuries unit is set to close at night forcing patients to attend the already overwhelmed Lister hospital. GP surgeries are struggling to cope, and parking in the town centre is frequently full at busy times. The objection is not about building here, it is about the density of dwellings and lack of open spaces that make a Garden City. I urge the planning committee to be sympathetic to the environment that is Welwyn Garden City respect the vision on which it was built."/>
