Comments	<input type="text" value="I write to object to the planning application to build up to 10 storey blocks of flats in Broadwater Road. Ten storey blocks will tower about the surrounding area, and be particularly unpleasant for those living nearby. The original plan submitted was to build 5 storey high blocks of flats. How will doubling this benefit WGC? Building even 5 storey blocks will change the look of the centre of what is, presumably, still a Garden City. The increase in traffic in the area will be horrendous. Broadwater Road is already busy at peak times and joining from the road is always difficult. This will be worsened with tailbacks increased, blocking other roads and increasing the traffic in adjoining streets as people rat-run to bypass Broadwater Road. Where is the infrastructure to support such a large population increase in what is a small area? What is being done to provide more doctors' surgeries, schools, policing, social amenities? I urge you to reject the application."/>
