Comments	<input type="text" value="The new proposal increases the number of dwellings from 643 to 929 and building height to 10 storeys. This contradicts the Broadwater Road SPD limiting building to five storeys except in exceptional circumstances. It is inappropriate for a Garden City, far too dense, overpowers neighbouring developments and lacking in green space and room to move. It will be more crowded than Manhattan in Central New York (793 people per hectare compared with an average of 275 in Manhattan). It will house just over 900 more people than proposed in the 2019 application. The local infrastructure will not be able to support this number of extra people."/>
