I would like to register my objections to the above in the strongest terms:

None of these proposals show any regard for the original concept of a Garden City.

The density, style, height, narrow spaces between blocks of flats, complete lack of any space for leisure or planting of shrubs, trees or grass for access to fresh air and the impact of vehicles on the surrounding road systems will produce major problems for the existing infrastructure and an extremely unhealthy situation for those living in the various zones listed above. It seems that the only intention of the planners is to crowd as many dwellings as possible into these areas without any regard to the health and well-being of those living there, and the unsuitability of the plans for the surroundings and traditions of the Garden City.
