Comments	<input type="text" value="Whilst I recognise the need for new housing and applaud the use of a brown field site, this development is a monstrosity. Many of the buildings are higher than Welhat Council's own recommended maximum 5 storey height limit. The densely packed, high rise nature of the site makes it look like the worst inner city development rather than being consistent with the, usually strictly enforced, 'Garden City' ethos. The development is not in keeping with the town's much loved green, open spaced feel. I'd imagine train passengers passing through the town would vow never to visit such a place - it would look like a terrifying 'no go' area. People who live here feel passionately about developing Welwyn Garden City in an appropriate and sympathetic way - this certainly is not it!"/>
