Comments	<input type="text" value="As a family we would like to strongly object to this proposal for the following reasons: - The proposed density and height of these buildings is total out of scale and proportion to Welwyn Garden City and the whole idea of a Garden City. - The insufficient parking spaces due to be allocated will put untold pressure on surrounding areas - The negative impact of such a high number of residents will have on the existing infrastructure, medical, education and other services (local schools are already at their full capacity, as are GP surgeries and dental practices) - The density of this development is far greater than inner London and is totally inappropriate and incompatible to WGC. We ask these development plans be revisited to reflect and be more in keeping with a Garden City rather than an inner city."/>
