Comments	<input type="text" value="This development suggests a building height of up to 10 stories, a complete blot on the landscape of WGC. Together with other developments in Broadwater Road it makes the numbers proposed far too dense in nature and lacking in essential greenery, part of the WTC landscape. No consideration has been given to the infrastructure, there is enough difficulty with GP's and school places at the moment without adding to the problem. By all means we have to provide housing, but on a far more pleasant/acceptable scale than is proposed. It is apparent that other parts of the Borough do not have any suggested developments of any size and in spite of the fact that they have excellent transport links and no doubt areas within them that could offer excellent housing. The need is for social housing, but the numbers proposed to not seem to be targeted at this area of housing."/>
