Subject: Re: Proposed Multi-Story Carpark at Campus West - Planning Reference: 6/2021/2207/MAJ.

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Dear Mr Lee,

With reference to the planning application reference 6/2021/2207/MAJ, i.e. the proposed multi-storey car park at Campus West, my wife and I would like to join with our neighbours in objecting to this planning application on the following grounds:

- The lighting on the top deck is too prominent;
- The trees and shrubs along Ayot Greenway (northern elevation) provide inadequate visual screening for local residents;
- There is insufficient cladding on the northern elevation to reduce noise, light and air pollution;
- There is insufficient cladding on the western elevation;
- The deck level comes too close to Woodside House;
- The proposed car park has inadequate security measures;
- The proposed car park should not be open 24/7 per week; and
- **No binding contractual measures are proposed to prevent 'scope creep' occurring in future. e.g. the addition of one or two more floor levels to the proposed scheme.**

Would you please consider, and in some cases, reconsider these objections as the planning application moves forward.
