

## Representations re Campus West Car Park Planning Application

The Leader of the Council has gone on public record stating that:

*" we will accept and take account of any representations received up until the point of decision as is our usual practice.*

*Please accept our apologies for any confusion caused and please be assured that all representations received prior to the DMC meeting will be reported to the Committee by officers."*

I understand therefore that the Planning Officer will report to DMC all new planning matters raised by residents and submitted by the 7 December deadline for representations. As these are new planning considerations not previously made, and lodged within the consultation time period, I would like them reported **in full** to DMC.

### **A new condition should be imposed to ensure that the lighting curfew is implemented, as set out in the report:**

A condition should be imposed to secure a 23.00 to 07.00 lighting curfew.

### **Additions to proposed conditions:**

**Condition 13:** The Landscaping Plan should be agreed by officers in consultation with the local members for Sherrards and Handside wards to ensure that all items set out in 13 (a) – (h) meet local concerns.

**Condition 16:** The Anti-Social Behaviour Management Plan as set out in condition 16 should also be agreed in consultation with the local members for Sherrards and Handside wards.

**Condition 16:** The ASB Plan's implementation should be monitored and, if after a year, it has not been successful in preventing any anti-social behaviour then car park closure should take place between 23.00 – 06.00.

The above is written on the basis that the decisions with regard to the two plans are delegated to officers. If this is not the case, then whoever has the delegation should still decide in consultation with the local members for both wards.
